PURPOSE OF WORKSHOP

School shootings have grabbed the attention of educators world-wide while suicides continue to increase.

Data and psychological autopsies revealed that bullying was a predisposing factor in school shootings. Now experts recognize that bullying is connected to both suicide and homicide.

Children who are suffering cry out for help in many ways. Those who care must learn to listen and respond in a nurturing way. Intervention and life skills are critical.

Potential victims of suicide may also become homicidal as well. Appropriate staff responses are critical in all three phases of response. Suicide may also be "copied" and replicated by others.

OBJECTIVES

Participants will learn:

- To Describe the prevalence of suicide (rates, methods, sex, age, changing trends)
- To Screen for risk factors (physical, social, mental/emotional, life events)
- To Contract with at-risk individuals, refer for intervention, provide continued support and assistance with transition back into the system
- Bereavement issues (survivor's grief responses, appropriate helping behaviors, appropriate remembrance activities)
- Crisis protocols (ideation, threats, attempts, completed suicide)

TRAINING MATERIALS

Participants in this workshop will receive a PowerPoint presentation and a site-based license to be used to train staff in their building. They will also receive sample screening surveys, confidential recording keeping forms, anti-suicide contracts, and sample crisis protocols.

She has experience as a program administrator and independent consultant. She provides grief and trauma counseling for adults and children. She is recognized nationally as a loss and recovery expert.
